PASTOR'S RESPONSIBILITIES: Some people have questioned the source of the Pastor's authority. By Church law, the Reverend Pastor exercises the three-fold office of sanctifying, teaching and governing the parish. The Finance Council, Pastoral Council and Parish Consultors are advisory bodies to the Pastor. The Pastor represents the parish in all matters and is the administrator of all of the spiritual affairs and temporal goods (property and finances) of the parish. These responsibilities are contained in legislation passed by Pope Saint John Paul II, the Particular Law of the Maronite Church and the Eparchial Statues of the Eparchy of Saint Maron of Brooklyn, and are the essentially same as those of the Pastors of Latin rite
