 1 \& 2 APRIL 20171. Lenten dietary regulations are as follows: Abstinence from meat \& meat products is observed on all Fridays of Great Lent. Abstinence is binding on everyone over the age of 14 years. Fasting from food and drink (except water and medicine) is observed from Midnight until Noon on Ash Monday and Good Friday. Fasting is binding on everyone between the ages of 18 and 60 years. Those unable to fast due to ill health must perform other penances \& works of charity; like attending daily Mass, Stations of the Cross, etc.
2. The Annual Bishop's Appeal is nearing the end. If you have not yet sent in your contribution, please do so as soon as possible and not later than Easter.
3. The ladies of the Sodality will be baking for our annual Palm Sunday Bake Sale on Wednesday, April 5, Thursday, April 6th, Friday, April 7th \& Saturday Apri 8th. Baking starts at 9:00 AM each morning. Please help whenever you can-and bring a friend(s).
